<b>Academic Levels</b>	Undergraduate and Graduate (Master Course) levels
<b>Faculties</b>	<p>At the undergraduate level, we have six faculties which are Humanities and Social Sciences, Education, Agriculture, Science, Engineering, and Informatics. The applicant's faculty will be decided on consultation with the organization and the faculties, the study plan will be referenced then.</p> <p>In the graduate (Master Course) level, we have the Graduate School of Humanities and Social Sciences, the Graduate School of Education and the Graduate School of Integrated Science and Technology.</p>
<b>Terms</b>	<p>Fall term : October 1 ~ March 31.</p> <p>Spring term : April 1 ~ September 30.</p> <p>You can chose one term (6 months) or two terms (full year)</p>
<b>Japanese Language Studies</b>	<p>Organization for International Collaboration provides Japanese language and culture classes for the international students. The class varies from the beginning level to the advanced level in the Japanese Language Studies. The study plan of students will be confirmed after consulting with their faculty advisor and academic advisor. <b>Academic Studies</b>	<p>Most classes in the undergraduate level are given in Japanese. If an applicant would like to study his/her major and to take these classes, the high command of Japanese must be required. There are a few introductory courses given in English. The details will be offered at the</p>

	<p>orientation at the beginning of each term.</p> <p>At the graduate level, some courses in the Agriculture, the Science, the Engineering and the Informatics may be offered in English. All the courses in the Humanities and Social Sciences and the Education are given in Japanese.</p>
<b>Obligation</b>	The exchange students are under obligation to take classes for more than 7 classes (10 hours) per week. They can choose classes depending on their study interests.
<b>Application</b>	Application must arrive by 29 <sup>th</sup> March 2019 through the applicant's university.
