The art of embroidery appeared later than the art of textiles. Embroidery is not purely concerned with making textiles beautiful, but rather, it is also intimately related to ritual ceremonies in which it enhances the essential solemnness of the atmosphere and environment. In Hue, the former imperial capital of Vietnam, the majority of decorations in feudal palaces as well as places of worship such as temples and shrines all enjoy the significant contributions of embroidery.
