

Program Core Focus

Thammasat Institute of Area Studies (TIARA) in collaboration with College of Interdisciplinary Studies, Thammasat University, offers a course-based master's degree program that seeks to build up well-rounded experts in matters related to Asia-Pacific. This program is in conjunction to the hype of already dynamic region that dubbed 21st century as the Asia-Pacific Century.

Program Details and Structure

The full-time master's degree program is designed for students to complete in 16 months (three semesters and one summer semester session). Students are required the completion of 39 credits comprising of 27 credit course work component and 12 credit research component. Students are also to take part in the Post-graduate International Conference organizing by TIARA and Thammasat University.

Program Structure

- A Bachelor's Degree in any field with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 and above from an accredited university
- Minimum requirement of English Proficiency is 6.5 IELTS (IELTS 6.0 is acceptable see NOTE), 550 for paper-based TOEFL test, 79 for internet-based TOEFL test, and 213 for computer-based TOEFL test or 550 for TU-GET. The official score report of English Proficiency is valid only if the test was taken no more than 2 years prior to the last date of the application submission period.
- A statement of purpose and/or academic essay of approximately 500 words.
