

Campus



The "Ao dai" is a Vietnamese traditional garment, now most commonly worn by women but can also be worn by men if it's New Years. In its current form, it is a tight-fitting silk tunic worn over trousers.









VIETNAMESE FOLK CULTURE















CUISINE

Vietnamese cuisine is distinct and unforgettable. The cuisine creates the balanceof salty, sweet, sour and hot flavours, achieved through the use of "nuoc mam", a fermented fish sauce, cane sugar or tamarind and chilli peppers. Dishes use plenty of fresh herbs with, as chilli sauces are served separately.

GOI CUON



Vietnam's most famous dish: translucent springrollspacked with greens, corianders and various combinations of minced pork, shrimp or crab. In some places they're served with a bowl of lettuce and / or mint. A southern variation has barbecued strips of pork wrapped up with green bananas and star fruits, and then dunked in a rich peanutsauce-every bit astasty as it sounds.

One of the Vietnam national dishes is "pho" (pronounced "fur"), a noodle soup eaten at any time of day but primarily at breakfast. The basic bowl of "pho" consists of a light beef or chicken broth flavoured with ginger and coriander, to which are added broad, flat rice noodles, spring onions and slivers of chicken, pork or beef.



BUN CHA



As a Hanoi specialty, you'll find Bun Cha at food stalls and street kitchens across the city. Essentially a small hamburger, the pork patties are barbecued on an open charcoal brazier and served on a bed of cold rice noodles with assorted foliage and a slightly sweetish sauce.

This baguette sandwich filled with greens and a choice of fillings, including paté and freshly made omelette, is so appetizing. It's been imitated around the world.

These enormous, cheap and filling Vietnamese pancakes (known as "sizzling pancake") contain shrimp, pork, bean sprouts and egg, which is then fried, wrapped in rice paper with greens and dunked in a spicy sauce before eaten.

CUISINE

BANH CHUNG



Square glutinous rice cake (known as "Banh chung") is a must-dish at Tet festival in Vietnam. It has square shape and symbolizes the earth. This cake is made from glutinous rice wrapped in green "dong" leaves. The filling is made from mung bean and pork belly. It is cooked in a big pot for about 10 hours. It's time for all the members of the family to gather around the fire and Chung cake's pot. To serve, the cake is peeled off and cut into 8 wedges from the middle. Banh chung has special and great taste which satisfy your appetite for the first time.

BANH TROI



The Vietnamese often make two kinds of cakes: banh troi (floating cake) and banh chay (lean cake) on the third day of the third month of the Lunar year. This is known as the "Cold Food Festival". In Vietnam, most people may have forgotten its origins but it's still considered a memorable occasion for ancestral offerings. The cakes are popular desserts in both rural and urban areas

Banh cuon is a very thin crepe from rice flour and stuffed with minced pork, mince black ungus and onion. The cook has to be skillful to make this cake. A layer of batter is poured onto the crepe which covers a pot of boiling water, the filling is added after that. This amazing cake is served hot with sliced cucumber, Vietnamese coriander, fried scallion, slices of pork pie and dipping fish sauce. This is one of the most delicious traditional foods in Vietnam. Do not miss this brilliant gem of Vietnamese foods.


CHA CA



Seafood dishes are among the standouts of Vietnamese cuisine. Chaca, originated in Hanoi, is perhaps the best known. It sees white fish sautéed in butter with dill and spring onions, then served with rice noodles and a scatering of peanuts.
